A1/ Summaries of Mid-term reviews (EPSRC)

A2/ Representative showcasing of all 5 Centres' results and achievements with a purpose—each Centre only showcases 2 types of work

a) New innovations that may be immediately used by others (novel tools) and for building new funding applications;

b) New and exciting work that could benefit from other expertise across UK to make a bigger impact (again candidates for future funding).

Works that are not yet completed or results inconclusive or unlikely to be used for future funding applications will not be showcased.

A3/ We invite presentations that are related to 2a and 2b from non-Centre and leading UK (or OS) groups, to represent UK, not just 5 Centres.

A4/ We invite clinical and industrial partners to give talks leading to new scoping of Maths-Healthcare challenges.

A5/ For 2-4, we initiate sandpit style discussions to prioritise the list of challenges and find a basis for new funding applications.
